







Regions of Employment



Global

Internationally, the largest percentage of graduates are in North America, with 49%. Of those, the vast majority were working in the sector of Human Health & Social Work, at 97%. Great Britain was the next largest taker, with 34%. Of those, Human Health & Social Work was again the sector with the most employed, at 55%, followed by Education at 23%.



Ireland

Nationally, the Mid West took the largest percentage of graduates, at 39%. Of those, 21% were in the fields of Human Health and social work. Education was the next highest, with 7%.

The East took 25% of graduates, with 12% of those going again to Human Health and Social work, and 7% to Education.
